1. MACHINE ELIGIBILITY

The below rules apply to machines competing in the Junior State Road Racing Championships promoted by the Motorcycle Racing Club of WA. All protests to be as per MOM GCR section 6.

All machines must meet GCR sections 7B, 7C and 7D, with 4-stroke machines also meeting 7.28, and two-stroke machines also meeting 7.27. The MA General Competition Rules (GCR) and this document which takes precedence over the GCRs.

2. FOUR-STROKE - 160CC MACHINES

As Per 7.28 (junior 160cc four-stroke) of the 2021 MA GCRs with the addition of the following items.

7.28.5: Permitted Additions. Add or amend to the following.

- d) Commercially available brake lever protection.
- e) Fuel injection units that plug into the original electrical connectors with no modification to the wiring harness
- f) Front springs, fork oil and fork top caps may be modified or replaced to include preload adjusters, but the external appearance of the forks must not be changed.

2.1. CLARIFICATIONS

- 7.28.4 Permitted Modifications. Amend the following to read;
 - g) Rear suspension springs.

3. TWO-STROKE – 85 CC MACHINES

As Per 7.27 (junior 85cc) of the 2021 MA GCRs, with the addition of the following items.

7.27. Add or amend the following.

- 7.27.3 Permitted Modifications
 - d) Front springs, fork oil and fork top caps may be modified or replaced to include preload adjusters, but the external appearance of the forks must not be changed.
 - e) Brake Friction materials and brake hoses
 - h) Rear suspension Springs.

7.27.4 Permitted Additions

- 7.27.4.1 The following may be added:
 - a) GPS lap timer only, the only electronic or other connection to the machine shall be for the purpose of power supply to the lap timer only.
 - b) Frame protective sliders
 - c) Radiator guards
